Invest in property in Europe and enjoy the benefits of a 'Golden Visa' in the process, writes **Andrea Pearson**

IF THE PANIC is starting to set in for real now ... it is time to follow the advice of the old maxim: when the going gets tough, the tough get going. Yup, with a fistful of euros you can buy your way back in to Europe with a "Golden Visa" property investment. Precise conditions vary from country to country – some ask for five years of residency, some for a language test, and entry points vary from €250k to €1m but none require a granny's birth certificate.

So if you just can't take it any more, check these options out for the glory of that short blue queue. ■

Greece

What's the deal?

Home to haloumi, hummus and divine fried fish, Greece opened its doors the Golden Visa in 2013 to encourage investment. It remains one of the most attractive programmes in Europe with a minimum investment of just €250k required. The renewable visa is granted for five years and can be upgraded to citizenship after seven years.

What's hot?

At the more luxe end of the market are Aman Villas at Amanzoe, a collection of private luxury residences at the Aman resort – arguably Greece's most exclusive residential community.

Perched on the highest hills Porto Heli – described by developers Dolphin Capital as "the Greek Riviera, a playground of the Greek jet-setting elite, synonymous with understated elegance", in the heart of the Peloponnes. Each villa has spectacular views over the Aegean and surrounding olive groves, swimming pools and spacious living and dining areas. The resort provides additional luxuries in the shape of an Aman Spa, several restaurants and a beach club. On the doorstep are scalloped beaches, archaeological sites, and access to myriad islands. One bedroom villas start at €3.2m.
